Southwest Launches Chicago Midway Service at GFIA



Grand Rapids, Mich. – Southwest Airlines (*NYSE: LUV*) continues to grow in the Grand Rapids (GRR) market as new service to Chicago Midway (MDW) from the Gerald R. Ford International Airport (GFIA) began today.

Southwest now offers nonstop service to six cities from GFIA, adding Midway to a list of flights to Baltimore/Washington, Orlando, Denver; and seasonal service to Tampa & Fort Myers. The new flights from Grand Rapids to Midway will operate three times daily.

Grand Rapids marked the 83rd city served in Southwest's route portfolio. Today, the airline flies to 97 cities in the United States, Mexico, and Caribbean.
